

Prof. hab. Marek Wierzbowski

Full professor of the Warsaw University, legal counsel, a partner in the Prof. Marek Wierzbowski Radcowie Prawni Spółka Partnerska law office. Prof. Wierzbowski is a member of Public Procurement Council, a member of the Central Council of Academic Title and Academic Degrees, a vice- chairman of the Supervisory Board of the Warsaw Stock Exchange. He is also a Supervisory Board member of several companies. Currently he is the President of the Arbitration Court of the Chamber of Brokerage Houses. Prof. Wierzbowski was a Pro Dean of the Law and Administration Division, as well as a pro-vice chancellor of the University of Warsaw. He was a chairman of the Securities Commission and he was also a vice – president of the Arbitration Court of the Polish Chamber of Commerce. For many years he was a senior partner in the international legal offices of Weil Gotshal & Manges and subsequently Linklaters. He has represented the Securities and Exchange Commission and the Commission of Banking Supervision before the Supreme Administrative Court. Prof. Wierzbowski lectured as a visiting professor at least for one semester on the law divisions at the American universities.
